Two Dozen Things You Can Do To Be an Encouragement!

1. Read scriptures with your friends, and in family devotionals.
2. Pray daily for the church, your friends, family and even your enemies.
3. Bring a visitor to meetings, Bible class and worship.
4. Design a bulletin board for a classroom or hallway at the building with a Biblical message.
5. Visit hospitals, nursing homes and/or children's homes and encourage the people there.
6. Collect food for the church food pantry.
7. Accompany your minister, elders, deacons, or a parent to make visits to those in the congregation or have visited the worship assemblies.
8. Share the good news of Jesus with a friend by setting up a Bible study.
9. Become a friend with someone at school or at your job that you do not know.
10. Mail or take Bible tracts or studies to friends and family.
11. Welcome all visitors to our assemblies.
12. Write letters and notes of encouragement to the sick, missionaries and church leaders.
13. Baby-sit for church members who need a night out or who are doing church work for the evening.
14. Share and send Christian websites to Christian and non-Christians.
15. Pick up trash, paper etc. in and around the church building as you encounter such.
16. Shovel snow, rake leaves or mow grass for church members and neighbors.
17. Take a day off and come to the church building to do some maintenance on the church building.
18. Invite someone from church to your home or out to eat for dinner.
19. Be an adopted grandparent to the children at church.
20. Give money to the church on the Lord's Day.
21. Volunteer for any work of the church you can do, before being asked.
22. Sing from your heart at worship.
23. Teach a Bible class.
24. Collect recyclable goods and give the money to the church to help the needy or missionary or to buy Bibles.
