Brother Dwane Casteel from Nashville, TN will be speaking to us this morning in worship and Bible Class. Brother Casteel works with the Churches of Christ Disaster Relief. Dwane is Married to Betty for fifty years on June 7. They have 3 children, 7 grandchildren, and 6 great-grandchildren. He has served 4 congregations during 40 years of preaching before he began to speak on behalf of Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort about 2 and 1/2 years ago. He has done mission work in China, Cuba, Dominican Republic and Jamaica. He also co-ordinates the Annual Caribbean Mission Forum each November. We appreciate so much all that is accomplished in the name of Christ through his efforts.

The following is some information taken from their web site: disasterrelieffort.org. "More than 85% of every donated dollar goes directly to disaster victims, 86.82% to be precise. Expenses such as salaries, utilities, supplies, maintenance, depreciation, truck rentals, etc. amounted to only 13.18%. We are proud of this remarkable record and acknowledge that without our many volunteers this could not be possible."

Churches of Christ Disaster Relief only works through the local Church of Christ in the community or town where the disaster has occurred. If there is no Church of Christ in the town, Disaster Relief will contact the nearest town that has a Church of Christ and ask for help. Supplies will be distributed by this congregation "in the name of the Lord" to anyone who has been affected by the disaster regardless of race, color, creed, or religion.
