What is the DBR?

What is the DBR? Notice 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, “Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that **Christ died** for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was **buried**, and that he **rose again** the third day according to the scriptures...” (Italics by author).

The DBR is the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, which Paul calls the Gospel or Good News. This question, “What is the DBR?” is the most important question that we can be asked. The death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus is the greatest gift that human beings could have ever received. This is because the death, burial, and resurrection accomplished the eternal plan of God to provide salvation from sin for each one of us. 1 Peter 2:22-24 states of Jesus, “Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.”

The message about Christ’s death, burial, and resurrection is so important that we as Christians have centered our lives around Christ and His death, burial, and resurrection by believing in it, living by it, and teaching it to all who will listen.

To answer this question the Bible is very clear. Jesus has paid the price for our sins on the cross (1 Peter 1:18-19). We respond to Jesus death, burial, and resurrection through our obedient faith – believing in Jesus and trusting Him (Acts 16:31), repenting of our sins (Acts 17:30-31), confessing Him before men (Romans 10:9-10), being baptized (immersed) for the forgiveness of our sins (Acts 2:38), and faithfully following Him for the rest of our lives (1 John 1:7). Have you responded to the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus? If not why not do it today!
