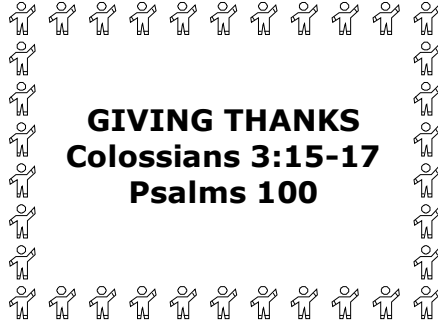
POINSETTIAS for Display
