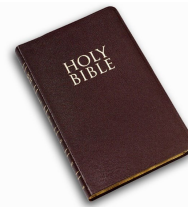



Verse of the week from Philippians:

"I can do all things through Him who gives me strength." Phil. 4:13

NO DOUBT!

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him," (John 3:16,17). *"Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so."* I know of no verse more frequently referenced, nor any song more fervently sung. God loves me! Jesus loves me! Profound truths! But, why?

Like some of you, there are times when I find myself wondering how God could possibly care about me, let alone love me. We have done nothing really noteworthy. We are not brilliant, talented, handsome, or financially independent. Yet, HE loves us! Who are we that God should shower His love on us so abundantly?

It's in pondering that questions that I think of my own children. They are adults now with lives of their own. To this day, we have never had cause to be ashamed of them. We have never had a single restless night of sleep because of them. They have never brought a tear to our cheeks other than tears of joy. They have been a blessing to our lives from the day they were born to this moment. There is nothing we wouldn't do for them and they know it. We are there for them twenty-four/seven! No matter what happens, they will always be our children, and we will love them.

It is possible, though I think it highly unlikely, that some day one of them might disappoint us, even break our hearts. But one thing is certain, we will never stop loving them. If we are capable of such love toward our children, how much more must that be true of our Heavenly Father? We are the offspring of God (Acts 17:29). We may disappoint Him, turn our back on Him, even reject Him, but He will never stop loving us (Romans 8:31-39).

He loves us, of that there is no doubt! (See also: 1John3:1, 16; 4:8, 10, 16.) But there is another side to all of this. Do we love HIM? That is the question that really matters. You see, if we do not love HIM, no matter how much He loves us, HIS love cannot protect us from the consequences of our bad choices, or save us from the horrors of hell, if we will not save ourselves! There is no doubt about His love for us, but our love for HIM is another matter altogether!
