Even though to *Sister Arlene* we are a world away, she had hope that *Robin* and *Jean* would keep their promise. They could only keep it because of you. I want to thank you for your generosity. Time and time again when needs arise, you all are so willing to give. It sure is good to be part of this congregation. You are aware that we were not able to send the items that were collected for the Daycare (planned to be shipped in October) but *Brother Dave* was able to take the money that was given, \$60,000 Guyanese dollars (\$300 US), to allow her to begin the needed repairs and purchase supplies. Some of you have read the complete letter from Arlene but for those of you that haven't here is a portion of it.

*".....First I must say, I received the money from Brother Dave. I must thank you all for keeping the end of your promise. A lot of persons promise but never get a chance to keep it up.....I can assure you all that I will never fail you or let this money dull my eyes. I will use it for, and only for the Day Care. Thank you, thank you, thank you, thank you, thank you.....I will not let you all down or let you hands fall, I will do my best.*
